Research Activities:

Since 2008, I have been conducting applied research in the field of combating crime and terrorism as an independent criminologist. My primary focus is on ensuring the safety of schools and other educational institutions (including preschools), as well as places where large numbers of children gather, from criminal and terrorist threats.

In 2008, while serving as an inspector-analyst in the Public Safety Department of the City Police Department, developed and implemented the «Sector» information and analytical system, which significantly improves the effectiveness of crime prevention, suppression, and detection on the streets and in other public places. The system remains in active use by the city police department.

In 2017, I personally developed a concept (including a complete set of draft regulations) and a «Roadmap» for the creation of a local (municipal) police service in the Russian Federation, as part of local government bodies (in Russia, all police forces are federal).

In 2020, with the aim of connecting independent researchers from various fields of applied criminology, as well as restoring and maintaining international connections among specialists, I developed and launched the «Public Order and Safety» portal. The portal was created as an independent online platform for hosting articles, projects, and other publications, as well as for discussions, debates, professional networking, networking with peers, and organizing collaborative work. Priority areas for research include: developing effective solutions aimed at ensuring public safety and improving the efficiency of police services and units, taking into account contemporary realities, technological advancements, changes in society, and current and emerging criminal and terrorist threats.
